Under deliverable D 8.4 a second version of the website <u>www.aal-rosetta.eu</u> has made (from first half of 2012 onwards) especially aimed at the care organisations of the long term care. Versions in four languages have been made.

Under the deliverable D 8.9 workshops for stakeholders in the Netherlands, Belgium, Germany and Italy were organized in the period of 2011 - 2012. The participants were mainly organisations for the long term care.

Especially in the last year of the ROSETTA-project as an AAL-project a number of presentations were given in congresses etc for the long term care in The Netherlands and Belgium (not specific scientific congresses).

There were also presentations in scientific congresses. Amongst others on a specific scientific congress on the subject dementia.

In May 2012 the book ''Zorgdomotica'' was published (Redaction Joost van Hoof, Eveline J.M Wouters, Fontys University Of Applied Sciences). It contains a separate chapter on the ROSETTA-system. One of the target groups of the book are the professionals in the care.

A publication is foreseen in the Dutch magazine "Denkbeeld". This is not scientific, but has as main target group the professional caregivers in the Dutch dementia care.
