1 Introduction

The EasyReach Website is the official window of the project to the outside world. It gives general information about the project and also makes possible the information interchange between partners through its private area. The website will be updated periodically to keep track of the project evolution.

The web site has been designed using a common structure. Some advantages of using standard headers, navigation blocks and footers are:

- They create a sense of corporate identity (or "house style") throughout the web site, which gives the impression that the pages are well-designed, authoritative and coherent.
- Consistency in design helps users to navigate through the site efficiently without being distracted by unexpected changes in page layout and navigation.

The most important part of the web design is its accessibility. The EasyReach web site has a universal design, to make it accessible to all people (whether they have a disability or not). The site allows eye-catching designs but create communication barriers. Also the user-interface and menus have been designed to permit the readers a simple navigation inside the website.

It is recommended to use of the W3C standard logos on conformant sites to help raise awareness of accessibility issues.

2 The Structure

The EasyReach website structure is shown in figure 1. The web pages are divided in three categories of functional modules: the Common modules, the Main modules and the Auxiliary modules. A short description of each module and the links transitions from one module to others are presented on table 1.


Figure 2: Links and transitions


Figure 4: 'About' EasyReach Project page






