1.1 The workshop purpose and objectives

- The purpose of HOPES 1st workshop was to present to AAL institutions (European and from each country) the results obtained after the first year of the project. No potential clients or investors were invited because, if the first prototype of the HOPES platform was created, the services part was not finalized and ready for prospection.
- The objectives were to:
 - Present the 12-month work global results,
 - Let each partner presents their work,
 - Receive feedbacks and advices from AAL JP,
 - Define next steps.
- Selected by AAL Forum award, HOPES presented its project and first developments. Among 4 finalists, HOPES was the third.

1.2 The place

HOPES first workshop took place in Lecce – Italy during the AAL Forum (from 26th to 29th September 2011).

1.3 The preparation

- The preparation lasted from July up to rehearsal the 27th September 2011.
- The workshop was held on 28th September 2011.
- The feedbacks from the following groups:

 - different phone conferences among HOPES partners,
