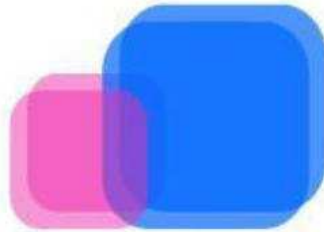

This section provides a brief description of the project and the objectives and main goals proposed by the consortium to archive along the duration of the SeniorChannel project.

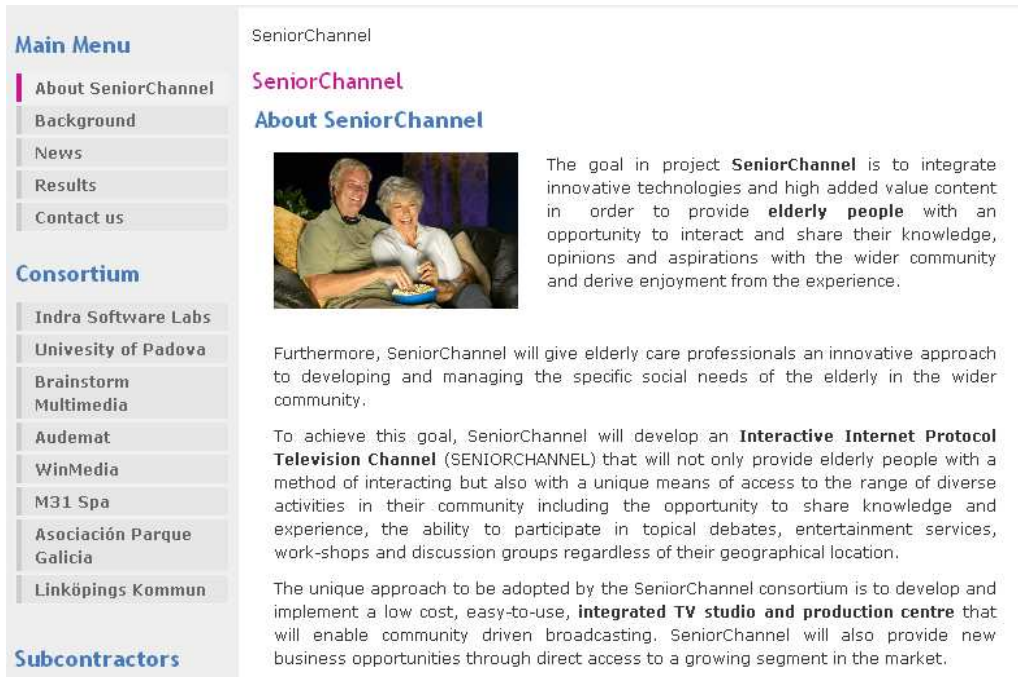


Fig 2 – About SeniorChannel section

Results section will be organized by annuities. In the annuity 2010 we have already some public results published.

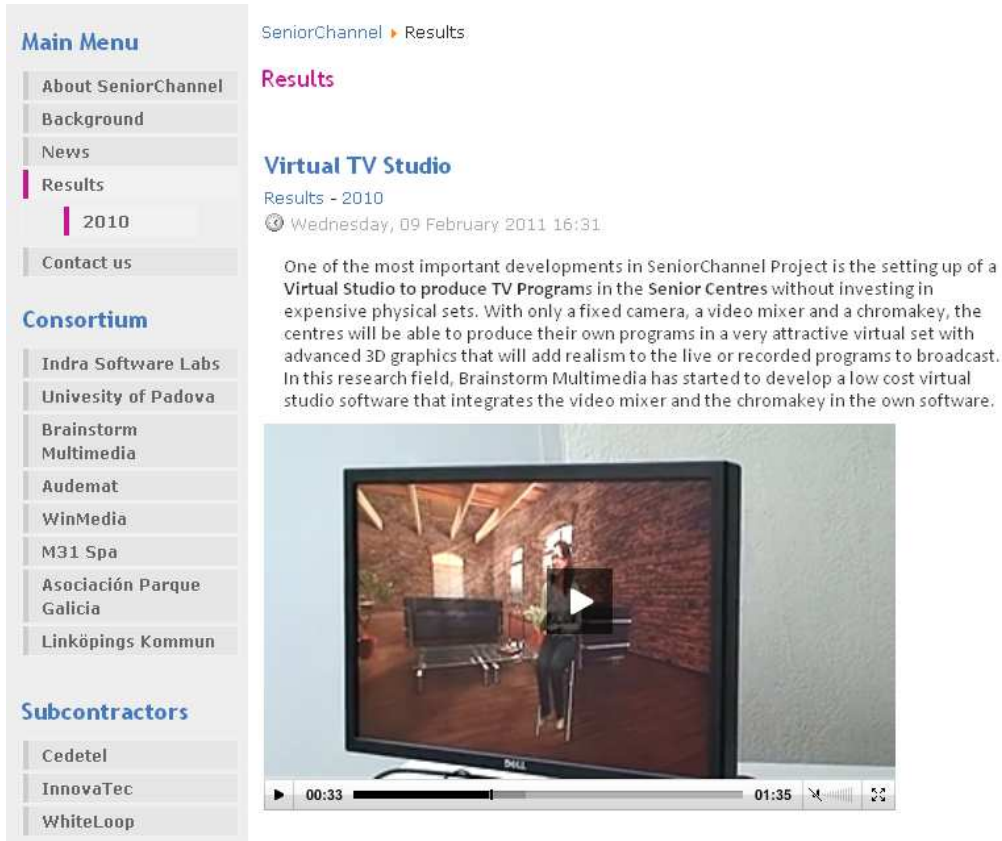


Fig 6 – Results Section

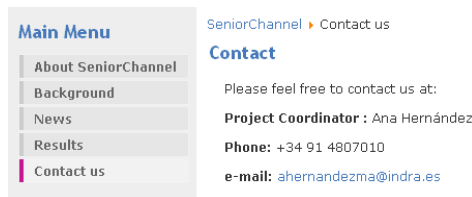


Fig 7 – Contact us Section
