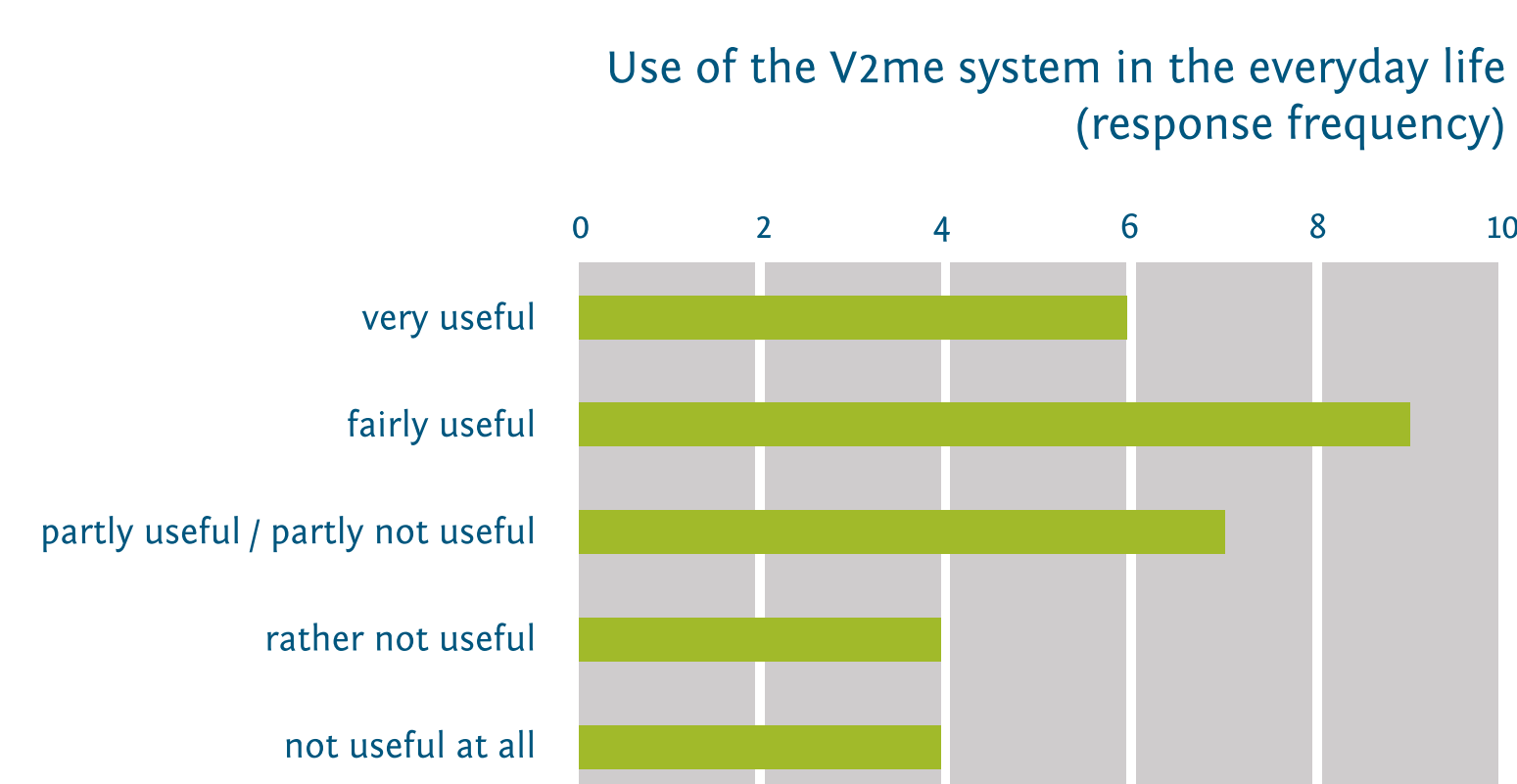

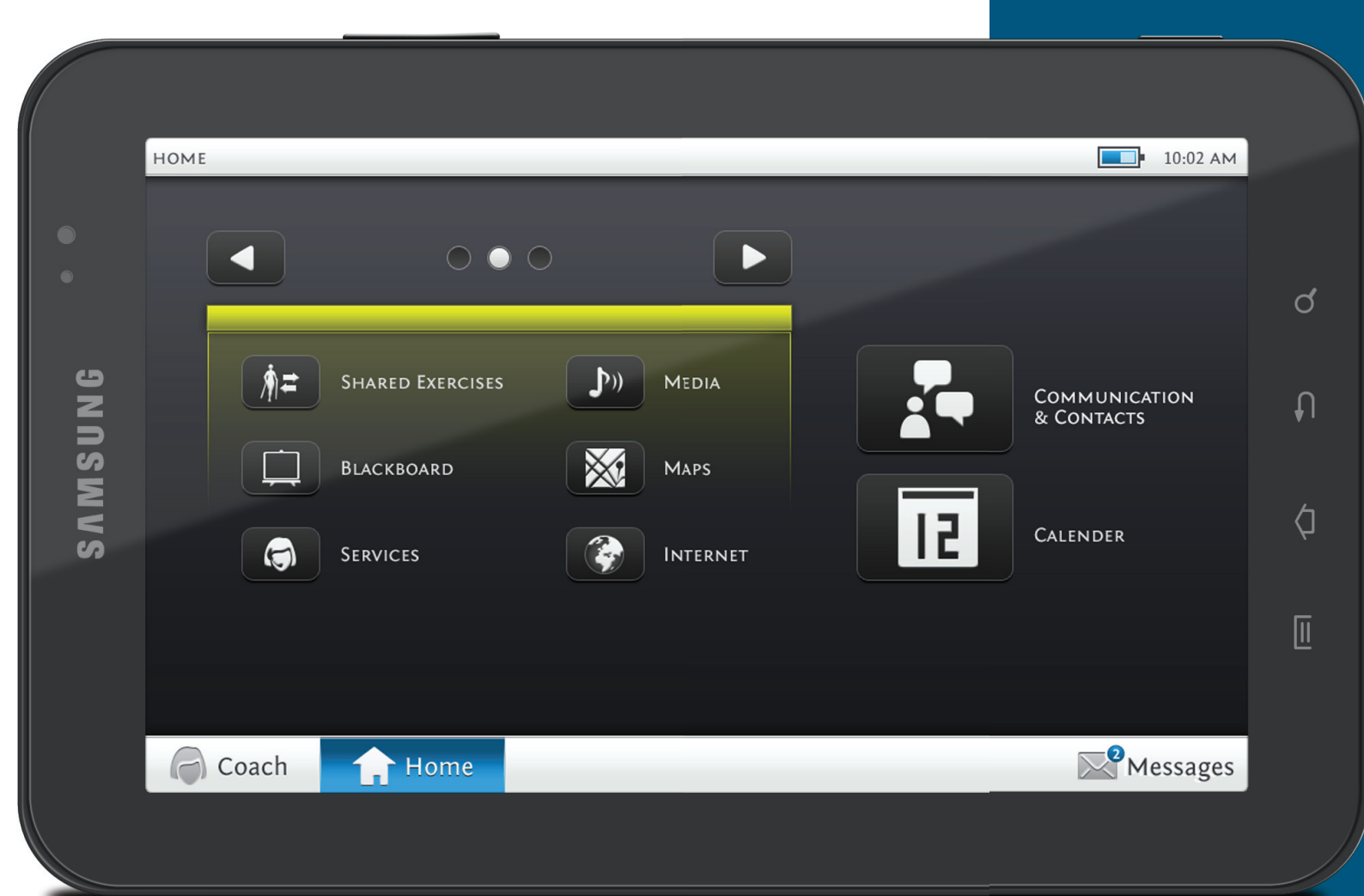


New technologies can be useful to plan and organise everyday life and activities (average rating - do not agree = 1, agree strongly = 5)
