## Restricted to programme participants

This document aims at developing a system demonstrator of the HEREiAM platform. The prototype allows the older adults involved in the trials to access a set of integrated services through their television and provides related formal and informal caregivers with access to up-to-date and meaningful information about care recipients through web portals or mobile applications. All the features of the prototype are described in deliverable D2.5.

The HEREiAM product demonstration requires the following equipment and facilities:

- 1 HEREiAM box
- 1 Smart Card
- 1 Webcam
- 1 HEREiAM remote control
- A set of Home sensors (i.e. PIR sensors, blood pressure monitor and weight scale)
- Access to an Internet connection - broadband wired or wireless (3G or 4G/LTE);
- Access to electrical power outlets;
- A HDMI-CEC compatible TV
