Based on the test report and the clinical feedback with the first prototype, we undertook to fix bugs, improve the performance and usability and implement optional functionality.

Two final software applications have been developed and the prototypes have been delivered, together with a comprehensive test report.

The A&S test was integrated in Cochlear's SHiEC dashboard and also in Audiqueen, Otoconsult's practice management software.
